

VoIP Tracker Lite

A little Voice-over-IP helper

What is VoIP Tracker Lite ?

VoIP tracker Lite is a monitoring application for your VoIP devices (currently only Sipura/Linksys devices are supported).

VoIP Tracker Lite displays basic information about your VoIP device so that you don't have to browse through a web administration interface.

You can quickly answer questions like :

- is my VoIP device correctly registered ?
- what are the current settings ?
- what are the current call settings (inbound/outbound, VoIP/PSTN, phone number, codec in use ...)

VoIP tracker Lite also let you restart your VoIP device with a click of a button.

VoIP Tracker Lite dress code

The application icon will change colour to quickly let you know the status of you VoIP device:

- original icon (orange) : no issues, no call in progress
- red : VoIP device not registered (you might not be able to use your phone or your calls are switched to PSTN)
- blue : VoIP call in progress
- green : inbound PSTN call in progress

Why building such an application ?

VoIP is a great technology but can be somewhat scary for non-technical people. As i needed a simple tool that could be used by anyone to check how VoIP was working and couldn't find any, I decided to code it myself.

Why "Lite" ?

Lite is there to suggest that this version is a basic version : it does simple things and does it well. Another version (VoIP Tracker) will include more advanced features (Call logs, backup configuration, Voice notifications ...)

What is the price ?


VoIP Tracker Lite is donationware. This means that if you find this software useful, I'll appreciate a donation.

Get Started in 4 easy steps

Step 1 : Start VoIP Tracker Lite

Step 2 : Type the IP address of your VoIP device



Step 3 : Click on "Start Monitoring"

Step 4 : You're done !!!!

VoIP Tracker Lite is under continuous development and we want to make sure that you always run the latest version.

As a result, an automatic update engine is built-in VoIP Tracker Lite and you can even change the way update checks are done

On the Settings tab, you can decide how often you want an update check to be done : when starting, never, weekly or monthly.
